



## Clergy Scholarship and Student Application for Enrolment

The Council of St Andrew's Cathedral School seeks to provide practical support to families by offering tuition fee remissions for ordained members of the Anglican clergy serving in Christian ministry through Anglican parishes and organisations. Through providing tuition fee remission, the School also seeks to involve the family of the student in the life and ministry of the school.

The availability of discounts is capped and at the discretion of the School. The level of tuition fee remission is dependent on the total family unit income. Council offers a discount based on the following scale:

- **Clergy:** A maximum total family discount of 70% less 30% of every dollar earned over the threshold (for School Year 2024, \$146,800).
- **Part time clergy:** will receive a pro-rata discount at the discretion of the Head of School.

Please contact the School Accountant for the discount that will apply to your particular family circumstance. The threshold will be adjusted annually in line with the increase in school fees.

Council advises that the level of discount made available to the Clergy is determined with reference to income. When applying for a clergy discount a declaration of family income is to be provided. Family unit income includes:

- Stipend
- Ministry Expense Allowance (whether payable or not)
- Income earned by a spouse
- Salary sacrificed for superannuation (both parties)
- Other taxable income received from rent, dividends, any other source (both parties)

The provision of housing, motor vehicle and non-taxable government benefits are not included in the family income calculation. If allowances are paid in respect of these, confirmation is required that they are fully expended for the purpose given.

Once enrolled, Clergy families are required to submit an annual income declaration in November of each year. Any variations in income which necessitate an adjustment to the level of discount provided will be effective from the next academic year. The declaration is a requirement for the continuation of the discount. The levels of tuition fee remission are subject to annual review by the Council.
